FACILITY UPDATES

Legacy Christian School completed several significant school improvement projects for the 2022-2023 school year. These projects were completed largely in part to making sure the school would be functional and upgraded before the start of the school year. Facility improvements included the following:

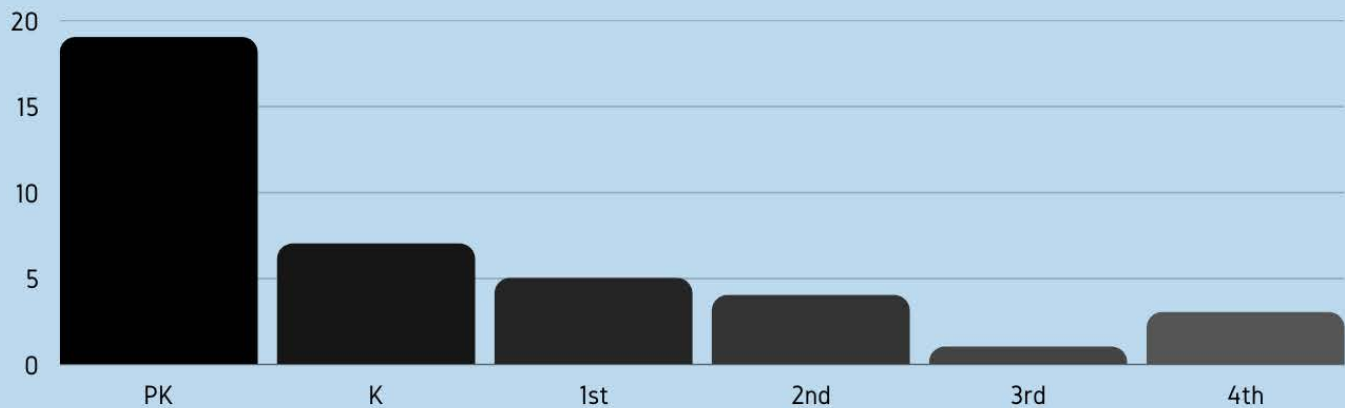
- Renovation to the west wing (PK & K rooms)
- Paint and carpet in the middle classroom
- Refinished gym floor
- New septic system
- Updated boilers
- A projector and projector screen for the gym
- 40 lockers installed for PK-4 students
- Cameras and security system installed
- Hallways and other classrooms painted

ACADEMICS

CURRICULUM

Led by 3 full time teachers, 2 part time teachers, 3 specials teachers, and 1 administrator, our students engage in an academic program that follows standards aligned with the Nebraska State Standards as well as integrate Biblical truth. Our Abeka, BJU, Friendzy, and Building on a Rock curricula bring daily Biblical reinforcement. Partnered with our weekly chapel time, the students are building positive character traits and developing their spiritual maturity.

MAPS TESTING

Students are tested twice a year to gauge their academic progress using the NWEA Measures of Academic Progress in the fall and spring. The MAPS results are unable to be publicized due to our small enrollment numbers, but we were thrilled to see high growth in nearly all subjects for all 1st through 4th grade students from the 2022 Fall test to the 2023 Spring test..
